- Classroom Grants \$37,683
 Provided grants for innovative programs and tools for teachers in the classroom.
- Donor Designated Grants \$11,947
 Coordinated donations made to donor designated schools or programs.
- Elementary Enrichment Grants \$64,000
 Collaborated with the Greater Albany Public
 Schools District and the Corvallis Arts Center to award enrichment grants to 15 elementary schools.
- Scholarships \$55,500 Awarded 29 scholarships to graduating seniors at the district's three high schools.
- Other Grants \$25,600
 Provided music instruments to all 15 elementary schools, funded the Sources of Strength suicide prevention program and more.
