## FOUNDATION AT A GLANCE

- **Classroom Grants - \$37,683**  
Provided grants for innovative programs and tools for teachers in the classroom.
- **Donor Designated Grants - \$11,947**  
Coordinated donations made to donor designated schools or programs.
- **Elementary Enrichment Grants - \$64,000**  
Collaborated with the Greater Albany Public Schools District and the Corvallis Arts Center to award enrichment grants to 15 elementary schools.
- **Scholarships - \$55,500**  
Awarded 29 scholarships to graduating seniors at the district's three high schools.
- **Other Grants - \$25,600**  
Provided music instruments to all 15 elementary schools, funded the Sources of Strength suicide prevention program and more.
