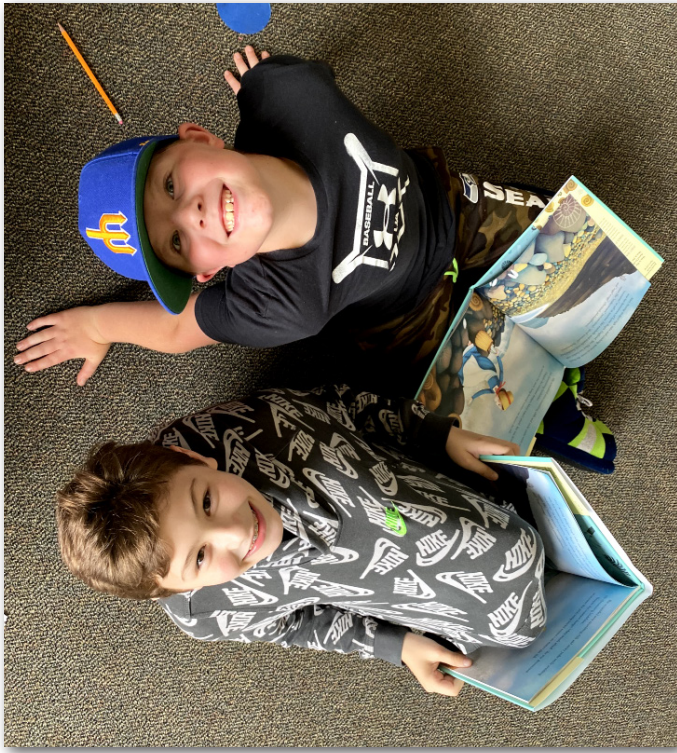

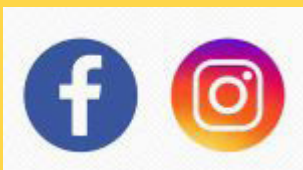

Peely's Teacher Supply House will provide school and classroom supplies to teachers at no cost. These are items that teachers often have to buy with their own money.

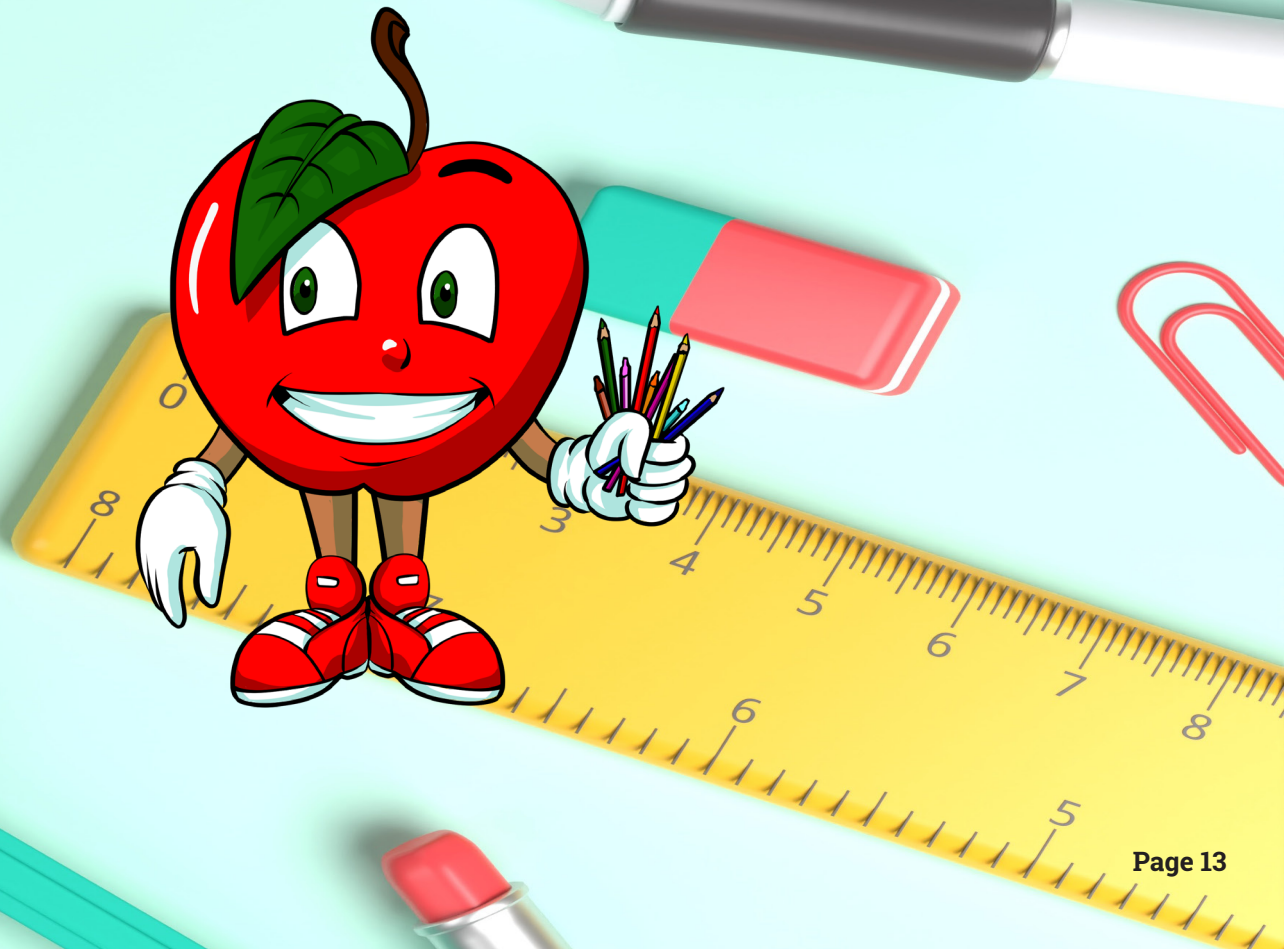
