### Greetings from the Albany Public Schools Foundation!

I hope you are enjoying the spring weather we have had in the Willamette Valley over the past few weeks. Before long, summer will be here.

We have been very busy with scholarship season in full swing. Our volunteer readers and donors have been reading through over **4492 applications**, which is up from 3764 last year. These applications were submitted by 244 students, which is up from 172 students last year. We are very proud that we will be giving out **144 scholarships, totaling \$252,300**. We wish we could give out more scholarships because as we know, this is life-changing to many of




### Central won Most Improved School for Participation at iSwim!




# EARTH WEEK GIVE 2025

"One of the main goals of middle school science is to get kids into the subject so that we can get them interested in STEM careers. Doing labs, especially edible labs like our candy compounds and DNA, really help get the kids excited about the subject. Most of us are spending \$500 or more on lab materials each year just to keep our programs at their current level. Our principal cannot afford to fund lab materials out of the school budget, either. We need grant funds to supplement what we have already spent in years past."


