

# Grant projects we're funding for 2025-26


The Albany Public Schools Foundation is thrilled to be awarding a record **\$107,035** in Classroom Grants and **\$26,590** in Big Impact Grants this fall!

A total of **127 Classroom Grant projects in schools across the district will receive funding**. Classroom Grants support projects in health and wellness, STEM (science, technology, engineering, math), art, music, and performing arts.

Big Impact Grants fund projects that connect two or more schools. This year, the Foundation is excited to be able to fund five projects that will benefit fourteen schools in Albany.

Grant funding helps teachers and staff enrich the educational environment for their students with projects, equipment, and materials that go beyond what the school district budget can provide. We appreciate your support in giving these opportunities to our students and teachers!

# Peely's Year-End UPDATE



In September 2024 when Peely's Teacher Supply House opened, through the following summer, we gave out about \$15,000 in school supplies to Albany teachers from Pre-K to 5<sup>th</sup> grade.

This year, starting August 25, we opened to ALL grades from Pre-K through grade 12. From August to December, we have given out over **\$22,000** in school supplies... and the school year isn't over yet.




